

Roy Shaw is Swiss 2019 Super Mini champion, and was 2018 Trofeo Vega champion. That qualified him for the IAME International Finals at Le Mans last year, when he finished 2nd in the B Final, and he was invited again to Le Mans for 2019. Roy won the 2019 Swiss championship with 8 race wins, 5 seconds, and 2 thirds out of 18 races over six race weekends. At the end of September, he had his first three days in a Junior chassis, achieving a podium in front of the 2018 and 2019 Swiss champion.
