

Roy Shaw is Swiss 2019 Super Mini champion, and was 2018 Trofeo Vega champion. He qualified for the 2018 IAME International Finals at Le Mans, and again in 2019, when he finished the A Final 22<sup>nd</sup>. Roy won the 2019 Swiss championship with 8 race wins, 5 seconds, and 2 thirds out of 18 races over six race weekends. On September 29th, 2019, his third day in X30 Junior, he beat the 2018 and 2019 Swiss champion to a podium. His first ever OKJ race weekend was the 2020 Winter Cup at Lonato.
